Mandatory requirement on tender security: **Original Tender Security of Kenya Shillings fifty thousand 50,000.00 from a reputable bank in the form of a Banker's guarantee or an Insurance Company Guarantee issued by an insurance firm approved by the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) valid for 120 days from the date of tender opening in the format provided in the tender document.**
