REUNIFICATION CLINIC IN HOMA BAY NET 1,036 CLAIMANTS, KSH 2.9 MILLION CLAIMED

A five-day reunification clinic in Homa Bay County has successfully netted 1,036 claimants lodging Ksh 2.9 million—signalling growing public confidence in the Unclaimed Financial Assets Authority's (UFAA) core mandate of returning lost assets to their rightful owners.

Speaking during the clinic, UFAA's Chief Executive Officer and Managing Trustee, Laban Molonko, reaffirmed the Authority's commitment to ensuring Kenyans recover unclaimed financial assets that rightfully belong to them. Molonko urged residents to take full advantage of the outreach exercise by verifying and claiming their 'lost and found' financial assets.

"I encourage the residents of Homa Bay county to turn up in large numbers and claim what rightfully belongs to them," Molonko said.

The initiative targeted residents of Homa Bay and neighbouring counties. It was designed to enhance public awareness of the unclaimed financial assets regime while taking reunification services closer to the people.

The clinic was preceded by an intensive three-day market storm, during which the outreach team traversed various parts of the county, tracing potential claimants and sensitising members of the public on the importance of checking for and reclaiming their unclaimed financial assets.

With over 1,000 claimants served and nearly Ksh 3 million lodged in a single county, the Homa Bay clinic demonstrates UFAA's growing reach and the increasing willingness of Kenyans to step forward and recover what is rightfully theirs.
